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**Meta.Morf is Trondheim's biennale for art and technology, and Norway's most extensive! The biennale is arranged for the third time this spring and similar to the preceding ones, organized and produced by TEKS - Trondheim Electronic Arts Centre. The exhibitions can be seen at various showrooms around the city in the period May 1 to June 1, 2014.**

**Meta.Morf** is an art biennale that aims to generate interest for the interface between science and art practices - and community development. This year's theme is trying to illuminate transformative processes and the aesthetic values they represent.

The biennale program presents through a month of exhibitions, conferences and concerts, a total of over 70 internationally renowned contemporary artists, architects, musicians, writers and researchers from 15 nations.
